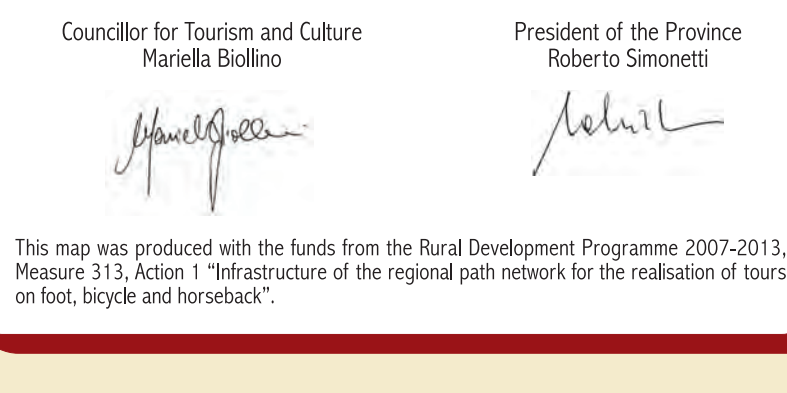


### Map of the Paths of Biellese
